## T.H. PROPERTIES SUSPENDS OPERATIONS, FILES FOR CHAPTER 11 PROTECTION; H&K, INC. RESPONDS WITH HUMILITY AND PATIENCE

<u>T.H. Properties (THP)</u>, a Harleysville, PA-based developer and homebuilder, announced Thursday, April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2009, that it would be filing for Chapter 11 Bankruptcy protection. This news follows the company's temporary suspension of operations on Tuesday, April 21, 2009. Given <u>Haines & Kibblehouse</u>, Inc.'s (<u>H&K</u>'s) history with <u>THP</u>, and our connection to several of their ongoing residential build-outs, this news was received with much concern at our corporate offices last week. This Press Release is provided to dispel any rumors or concerns regarding the impact of <u>THP</u>'s situation on our business.

<u>H&K</u> has been associated with <u>THP</u> since they began their business operations in 1992. Given <u>H&K</u>'s base of operations in Skippack, PA, a strong regional rapport and business connection developed between the two companies, and <u>THP</u> consistently ranked as one of our top clients. <u>H&K</u> has worked on many <u>THP</u> development projects through the years, and we continued to work on landmark <u>THP</u> projects up to the point at which their doors were closed on April 21<sup>st</sup>. This being said, our ties to <u>THP</u> have remained strong, and in difficult times like these, humility, patience and loyalty to our customers is "the H&K way."

To dismiss rumors that have surfaced about <u>H&K</u> absorbing or acquiring <u>THP</u> assets in the form of properties or holdings, no such plan or intent is currently on the table. However, it can be stated at this time that <u>H&K</u> has and will continue to work directly with <u>THP</u> to find a creative means of working through their financial difficulties. Within the several closed-door meetings that have occurred between <u>H&K</u> and <u>THP</u> since April 21<sup>st</sup>, there has been an air of confidence, solution and success to the ongoing discussions. Despite the flood of rumors and speculation of the last week, <u>THP</u> continues to be highly regarded both at <u>H&K</u> and within the local business community at large. One cannot and should not dismiss the fact that <u>THP</u> is still recognized as one of the nation's top builders and let us not lose sight of the fact that <u>THP</u> is yet another victim of the economic crisis. At <u>H&K</u>, we certainly cannot dismiss this fact, and we will continue to do everything in our power to continue to stand by them.
